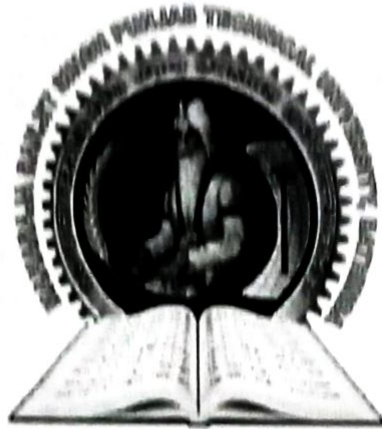

Item No. 3.7. Clarification in rules and regulations for Inter- College tournaments:-

It is proposed that item no. 2.2.1 should be amended as below:-

In case of team game, a College does not participate in an inter College tournament after confirming its entry or due to ineligibility of players, it would be fined Rs. 3000/-. In case of individual events, if players do not participate in an inter College tournament after confirming their entry or due to ineligibility would be fined Rs. 1000/- per player, but in all circumstances the maximum fine shall be Rs. 3000/- for a College. This fine shall be recovered by the University Directorate of Sports before the participation of respective College in next sports event (Tournament, trials etc.)

Matter is placed before the committee for consideration and approval please.

Item no 3.8 . Indiscipline by players of SBSSTC, Ferozpur during MRSPTU Inter-College Volleyball Tournament.

In volleyball Inter-College tournament, the final match of men section was played between SBSSTC, Ferozpur and GZSCCET, Bathinda. The players of Ferozpur team exhibited gross indiscipline and disrespect towards the conduct officials. The committee as approved in Agenda item No. 1.1.8a decided the matter as per rules. Decision is placed at (Annexure V page No. 20)

In the same context, Observer of the Tournament recommended strict action against the players (Annexure VI page No. 21-22). So, it is proposed to debar all the players of volleyball team of SBSSTC, Ferozpur who were involved in indiscipline from participation in any MRSPTU Sports activity for session 2017-18.

Item no 3.9 . Amendment in the rules for selection of University teams:-

It is proposed that the players to represent the University team shall be selected on the basis of their performance in inter College tournaments and selection trails. Trails shall be conducted after final match of Inter-College tournament on the same day. If a player belongs to the College from which the team did not participated in the tournament, he/she may be allowed to participate in the selection trial after receiving trial fees Rs. 70/- and subject to his/her eligibility as per MRSPTU & AIU rules.

Important note: If inter College tournament is scheduled after Inter University competition then University team shall be selected on the basis of performance in selection trails.

Item No. 3.11. Regarding structural design of Multipurpose Hall and Gymnasium

As architecture design of Multipurpose Hall and Gymnasium has already approved by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor but due to its longer span/complexity of structure, permission may be granted to hire external structural Designer/Agency. The consultancy fees shall be as per previous approved rates of GZSCCET, Bathinda.

Calendar for above listed games shall be prepared as per the sports calendar of AIU & Academic calendar of MRSPTU with the permission of Hon'ble Vice chancellor. Consent for hosting inter College tournament shall be invited from the affiliated Colleges in the prescribed Performa. Format of calendar is placed at **(Annexure- VIII Page No.25)**

Item No. 3.13 Participation in Inter-University competitions for session 2017-18.

It is proposed to field all the teams in the Inter University tournaments, for which University organizes Inter-College competitions. In no circumstances a game not recommended by the Sports Executive Committee shall be fielded in the inter University tournament.

In case of outstanding sports persons belong to the games in which University does not organize Inter-College competitions. Selection trials shall only be conducted with the permission of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, if case forwarded by the Principal/Director of concerned College to Director Sports well in advance with Authenticated proofs of students' performance.

However, if the selection committee feels that performance of players is far below the Inter-University standards then the committee may reject the selection of University team.

Item No. 3.14 Empowering the Vice Chancellor to take decisions in case of any urgent Matters.

Item No. 2.1 Confirmation of the proceedings of the 1st (last) Sports Executive Meeting of MRSPTU, Bathinda.

Decision: Confirmed.

Item No. 2.2 Action taken report on the decisions taken in the 1st Sports Executive Meeting of the MRSPTU, Bathinda held On 20th October, 2015.

Decision: Confirmed.

Item No. 2.3 Instructions for the team managers for filling Eligibility Performa for Inter college & inter varsity competitions

Decision: Approved, revised eligibility performacan be accepted 3 days Prior to competition.

Item No.2.4 Amended Instructions for the team managers accompanying university teams for Participation in all India Inter-varsity tournaments

2.4.1 DA for students attending coaching camp and participation in the Inter-Varsity tournaments including journey days is proposed to be enhanced to Rs. 200/- per day from the existing Rs. 175/- per day per student.

Decision: Approved

2.4.2 DA for Team Manager during Coaching Camp is proposed to be enhanced to Rs. 500/- per day from the existing Rs. 200/- per day.

Decision: The committee felt that amount paid to team manager and coach it should be treated as hospitality allowance instead of DA and it should be at par with coach. The rate to team manager is enhanced to Rs. 300 per day against the proposed Rs. 500 per day.

2.4.3 The refreshment for participating students during Inter Varsity tournaments is proposed to be enhanced to Rs. 100/-per student per day from the existing Rs. 50/- per day per student.

Decision: Approved for each participating day.

Item No2.5 Proposed Grant for hosting MRSPTU Inter-College Cricket Tournament

Decision: The committee approved grant to the host college for inter college tournament at rate Rs. 4200 per match against the proposed rate of Rs. 5000 per match.

Item No2.6 Misbehavior/Indiscipline by students of BFCET, Bathinda during 1st MRSPTU Athletic Meet.

Decision: The matter was discussed in detail. The committee has approved the proposed action recommended by observer of the Athletic Meet.

Item No2.7 Creation of Sports Infrastructure in University Campus

Decision: The matter was deliberated at length. Director, Sports and Youth Welfare told that a team of sports officials visited the multi- purpose halls of MDU, Rohtak and Chaudhry Devi Lal University, Sirsa. It was decided that hall with latest facilities (comprising of sports hall, shooting range and gymnasium hall) be setup near the existing campus grounds. The committee also approves the name's of Ar. Bhupinder pal Singh Dhot, Ar. Taranjit Singh and Ar. Gourav Jindal from Architecture department as consultants. The consultancy fees shall be as per previous approved rates of GZSCCET, Bathinda.

Item No. 1.Regarding General Fitness Marks:-

As per the new syllabus scheme of MRSPTU 2016 there is no provision of general fitness marks. Dr. Jaskaran Singh Bhullar Principal MIMIT, Malout was of opinion that general fitness marks should included to ensure maximum

participation of students in co-curricular activities. The matter was discussed in detail. The issue was deferred by the chairman of Sports Committee citing the complexity of awarding marks to the students.

Decision: Deffered

Item No. 2. Regarding weight age of various sports events for overall championship/ trophy.

Dr. S.S. Randhawa (Assistant Director Sports, IGK PTU, Jalandhar) has suggested that weight age to the first three positions in sports while deciding the winner of overall Trophy should be as under.

Item No. 3. Regarding conduct officials for Inter college competitions.

Officials/representatives of various officiated colleges requested that to maintain the credibility of various competitions to conduct inter college tournaments, department of sports & youth welfare should prefer to hire conduct officials from far away places from the host institute. Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Chairman has agreed for the same.

Decision:- Agreed

Item No. 4. Regarding overall championship in inter college Athletics competition.

A detailed discussion was held on this issue. As per the existing pattern/rules only top three positions has been considered to calculate the total marks for awarding overall championship in athletics. Most of the members were of opinion that instead of top three positions, top six positions of individual as well as relay events should be considered for the weight age as Below:-

1. -- 7 marks
2. -- 5 marks
3. -- 4 marks
4. -- 3 marks
5. -- 2 marks
6. -- 1 marks

Decision:- Approved

Item No. 5. Regarding inter college Kit colour:-

Dr. S.S Randhawa and Dr. Randhir Singh has suggested that colour code of sports kits for different affiliated colleges be fixed.

Decision:- Approved, noted for compliance.

Item No.6. Regarding inter varsity dresscolour coding:-

This matter was projected by Dr. S.S Randhawa and discussed at length. It was decided that two colour (Light and Dark) should be finalized soon.

Decision:- Approved.

Item No.7. Regarding participation in AIU tournaments during semester exams:-

Matter was brought to the notice of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Chairman of the committee that university players participating in AIU inter university tournaments miss their final exams. Members suggested that the participants of AIU tournaments may be allowed to appear for the same by rescheduling the examination by controller of examination.


Decision:- Approved, information about the decision shall be passed on to COE of university.

Item No.8. Regarding Remuneration to Director/ principal of host colleges:-



Sub- INCENTIVES FOR UNIVERSITY SPORTS ACHIEVERS (Men & Women Both)

The committee constituted for the purpose deliberated the matter in detail, on incentives like fee concession/ cash prizes for the year 2017-18 in regards to sports activities and related AUJ activities.

The following were agreed upon unanimously

1	Player(s) who wins 1 st , 2 nd or 3 rd position while representing India in International/ World Championships including Olympic/ Asiad/ Commonwealth as a part of official Indian contingent and has won 1 st , 2 nd or 3 rd position in Inter-Zonal of AIU approved games only and/or National/Sr National/All India Championship in the game/event in which the player is representing India, as recognized by MRSPTU at any time, while on the rolls of MRSPTU	Rs 10000/-, 75000/- and 60000/- only each for 1 st , 2 nd and 3 rd position respectively both for Individual or each member for a Team event OR Full Tuition Fee concession only for the next academic year, whichever is higher
2	Player(s) who shall participate in International/ World Championships including Olympic/ Asiad/ Commonwealth while representing India, as a part of official Indian contingent and has won 1 st , 2 nd or 3 rd position in AIU Inter-Zonal, AIU approved games only and/or National/Sr National/ All India Championship in the game/event in which the player is representing India, as recognized by MRSPTU	Rs 40000/- only for Individual and Rs 20000/- for each member for a Team event OR Half Tuition Fee concession only for the next academic year, whichever is higher
3	Player(s) who has won 1 st , 2 nd or 3 rd position in All India AIU Inter-University in AIU approved games only and/or National/Sr National/ All India Championship in the game/event in which the player is representing the University or State as a part of official University/State contingent, as recognized by MRSPTU	Rs 40000/-, 30000/- & 20000/- for Individual and Rs 70000/-, 60000/- & 50000/- only for each member for a Team event for 1 st , 2 nd and 3 rd positions respectively OR Half Tuition Fee concession only for the next academic year, whichever is higher
4	Player(s) who has won 1 st , 2 nd or 3 rd position in the Zone in which Punjab state falls in AIU Inter-University of AIU approved games only and/or State Championship in the game/event in which the player is representing the University as a part of official University contingent, as recognized by MRSPTU	Rs 10000/-, 9000/- & 8000/- only for Individual games and Rs 5000/-, 4000/- and 3000/- only for each member for Team event for 1 st , 2 nd and 3 rd positions respectively
5	Player(s) who creates a new record in events in Inter-College of MRSPTU (in AIU approved games only) in the game/event in which the player is representing the College as a part of official College contingent	Rs 1000/- and Rs 750/- each for Individual and team event respectively, provided atleast 15% of total affiliated colleges strength competes in the event
6	Best Athlete (Men and Women) in Inter college Athletic Meet Tournament	Rs 2500/- each provided atleast 15% of total affiliated colleges strength competes in the tournament
7	Cosch and Manager recognized by the MRSPTU for representing India in higher level championship per event (Athletics shall be considered as one event)	Rs 7500/- and Rs 5000/- each for 1 st , 2 nd or 3 rd position and 5000/- and 4000/- for participation

Other points:

1. The above is subjected to the condition, that the above event performance shall hold good for per academic year game event only
2. The award winning player shall be entitled for higher award only in case of multi-event positions or multi-award winnings. Athletics shall be considered as one event.
3. Award shall not be transferable under any circumstances. e.g. if any dispute arise due to any circumstances for the top/1st position, then award shall not be transferred to runners up/ 2nd position under any circumstances
4. For Cultural activities the same as above are recommended with the word sports/game to be read as cultural activity.
5. Awards shall be presented in the next succeeding year only.
6. In case of bracketed positions, rule of Tie-breaker shall be employed
7. No institution or organization shall have any claim on the awards won by the player(s) by virtue of his/her performance during the game/event which won him/her the position
8. No Championship/Tournament other than the mentioned above shall be considered for awards

11 Conduct of play : umpires

- 11.1 Two umpires control the match, apply the Rules and are the judges of fair play.
- 11.2 Each umpire has primary responsibility for decisions in one half of the field for the duration of the match.
- 11.3 Each umpire is responsible for decisions on free hits in the circle, penalty corners, penalty strokes and goals in one half of the field.
- 11.4 Umpires are responsible for keeping a written record of goals scored and of warning or suspension cards used.
- 11.5 Umpires are responsible for ensuring that the full time is played and for indicating the end of time for each half and for the completion of a penalty corner if a half is prolonged.
- 11.6 Umpires blow the whistle to :
 - a start and end each half of the match
 - b start a bully
 - c enforce a penalty
 - d start and end a penalty stroke
 - e indicate a goal
 - f re-start the match after a goal has been scored
 - g re-start the match after a penalty stroke when a goal was not scored
 - h stop the match for the substitution onto or off the field of a fully equipped goalkeeper and to restart the match on completion of the substitution
 - i stop the match for any other reason and to re-start it
 - j indicate, when necessary, that the ball has passed wholly outside the field.
