ITEM NO. 01.03: APPROVAL OF SYLLABI OF POST GRADUATE PROGRAMMES

DECISION: The Syllabi of Programmes contained in the following **Table-II** were approved with the observations/recommendations that,

 Additional Specialization 'International Business' may be offered in M.Com. from 3rd Semester.

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- Four Specializations (Finance, Marketing, HR and Operations) have been approved for MBA for 2016-17 Batch, both for MRSPTU Main Campus, Constituent Colleges & Affiliated Colleges. These specializations are also approved for Constituent Colleges & Affiliated Colleges for 2017-18 Batch.
- 3. MRSPTU Main Campus, Constituent Colleges & Affiliated Colleges will be free to offer any of the approved Major/Minor or Super Specialization in MBA.
- 4. A specialization will be offered, only if, at least 5 students opt for that Specialization.
- 5. Option from students for Specialization in MBA will be taken at the end of Second Semester.
- 6. Updated list of Open Electives with wider scope will be prepared and submitted by BOS (Commerce and Management) keeping in mind the problem that any College may face where a sole Programme is being offered.
- Student will submit their Synopsis/Research Proposal in 3rd Semester and final report will be submitted in 4th Semester. The presentation on final Research Project will be taken, subsequently.
- 8. External viva will be conducted for Minor Project I and Minor Project -II.
- 9. Redistribution of Credits in the Study Schemes will be provided by BOS in Commerce & Management, keeping in view that sum of credits of odd and even Semesters in a particular year should be even.
- Proper text/reference of books are to be given at the end of syllabus of each subject, in a uniform format. For example, Author, 'Title', Vol., Edition, <u>Publisher</u>, Year.
 - Author, The, Vol., Euthon, <u>Tubisher</u>, Tear.
- 11. Internal Assessment may include Field Work up to 20%.
- 12. In case of M.Com., there may be three specializations instead of two.
- Efforts should be made that Study Scheme be designed in such a manner that there are 70% Core Courses, 20% Departmental Electives and 10% Open Electives.
- 14. The Course Syllabus and external examination paper may include Case Studies.
