

QUALIFICATIONS FOR TEACHING POSTS

1. ASSISTANT PROFESSOR IN AERONAUTICAL/ AEROSPACE ENGG. AND MECHANICAL ENGG.:

i. **Essential:**

A Ph.D. Degree with First Class Master's Degree in the appropriate branch of Engineering (Engg.) & Technology (Tech.).

ii. Without prejudice to the above, the following conditions may be considered desirable:

1. Teaching, research industrial and/or professional experience in a reputed organization;
2. Papers presented at Conferences and/or in refereed journals.

2. ASSISTANT PROFESSOR IN MANAGEMENT:

i **Essential:**

1. A Ph.D. Degree with First Class Masters Degree in Business Management/ Administration in a relevant management related discipline or first class in two year full time PGDM declared equivalent by AIU/accredited by the AICTE/UGC;

OR

2. A Ph.D. Degree with First Class graduate and professionally qualified Chartered Accountant/ Cost and Works Accountant/ Company Secretary of the concerned statutory bodies.

ii. **Desirable:**

1. Teaching, research, industrial and/professional experience in a reputed organization;
2. Papers presented at Conferences and/published in refereed journals.

3. ASSISTANT PROFESSOR IN TOURISM MANAGEMENT:

- (i) A Ph.D Degree with Master in Business Management/ Administration or Masters in concerned/relevant discipline (like Airline, Tourism, Hospitality or their combination) with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in point scale) from a UGC approved University or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University by AIU/AICTE/UGC.

- (ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D.



Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- a. The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- b. The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c. An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d. The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
- e. The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC / ICSSR/ CSIR or any similar agency.

Note: NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.

4. **ASSISTANT PROFESSOR IN MATHEMATICS:**

- (i) A Ph.D. degree with Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- (ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET :

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:-

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;

- d) The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;

- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC / ICSSR/ CSIR or any similar agency.

Note: NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.
