Decision: Noted

Item No. 3.4 **Conduct of Youth-festival 2017-2018**

Decision: i) BBSBEC, Fatehgarh Sahib has given its consent to conduct university Youth Festival 2017, The proposed dates for the Youth festival 2017-18 shall be 2nd -3rd November 2017.

ii) "**Mehak Mitti Di**" was approved as the theme of Youth Festival and due thoughts shall be given to the theme while preparing events of Poem recitation (Self written), Poster making, Rangoli, Cartooning, Collage making, Debate and Quiz (One round).

Item No. 3.5 **Observers Suggestions**

Decision: Noted with modification in point no. I, ii.

Point no. i, Judges should sit apart from each other during judgment of their respective events and as far as possible, local judges should be avoided for the judgment of various competitions to be held in future during youth festivals.

Point no. ii, Duration of Youth Festival should be of two days only.

Item No. 3.6 **Proposal for Actual TA for Participating Days.**

Decision: Confirmed with modification that Dean Student Welfare deptt MRSPTU, Bathinda will issue the concession forms to the concerned deptt, well in time. Due to non-availability of Railway concession forms or any other reason, contingent/participants will be paid as mentioned in agenda item.

Item No. 3.7 Disciplinary Action

Decision: Approved. It was also decided that only senior faculty /cultural coordinator should be appointed as accompanying official by the respective participating colleges/ institutes.

Item No. 3.8 Budget provision for Cultural Activities of University 2017-18

Decision: Noted and Confirmed.

Item No. 3.9 Empowering the Vice Chancellor to take decisions in case of any urgent matters related to Cultural Activities.

Decision: Approved


Apart from above items of agenda, the following concerns/suggestions have been made by the committee members as table agenda with the permission of chair,

1. Prof. Amandeep Singh raised the Issue regarding holding the competition in an event in which there is only one entry. It was decided that Judgement will be done in such events and result shall be announced even if single entry is there in a particular event.
2. Dr. Gursewak Lambi suggested that Group dance (Regional) event should be introduced to promote other dance forms of the different regions. The committee approved the decision with the condition that all Punjabi folk dances will be not included in this.
3. It was also decided an amount of Rs.2000/ is to be deposited as a security (Refundable) by each participating college/institute along with the eligibility Performa's. if any college/institute does not participate in an Inter College Youth Festival after confirming its entry or due to ineligibility of participants, security amount will be forfeited. This amount shall be recovered by the Directorate of Sports and Youth welfare department University
