- Dr. Gursewak Lambi suggested that Group dance (Regional) event should 2. be introduced to promote other dance forms of the different regions. The committee approved the decision with the condition that all Punjabi folk dances will be not included in this.
- It was also decided an amount of Rs.2000/ is to be deposited as a security 3. (Refundable) by each participating college/institute along with the eligibility Performa's. if any college/institute does not participate in an Inter College Youth Festival after confirming its entry or due to ineligibility of participants, security amount will be forfeited. This amount shall be recovered by the Directorate of Sports and Youth welfare department University
