The balance affiliation fee will be required to be deposited before the issuance of their affiliation letter. 1. It was decided that institutes who have not deposited Endowment Fund or have deposited Endowment Fund for the less duration, must deposit the Endowment Fund with MRSPTU, Bathinda for the period of 10 years/remaining period, along with their application for the Academic Session 2019-20, failing which their application shall not be accepted. 2. It was decided that the old affiliation and other record available with the office of Director, College Development Council, MRSPTU, Bathinda should be digitized prior to disposing it. Status of digitized record shall be intimated in next BoG meeting. 3. It was ratified that for cases against the affiliated colleges, in which university is also made as party, concerned College will defend the case, on behalf of the University, through an advocate hired by the College. All the charges of the advocate will be paid by the concerned college. University should only send the Vakalatnama, duly signed by Registrar, MRSPTU, Bathinda in due course of time. The recruitment process of regular faculty members is underway. Every effort shall be made to complete the recruitment process. Meanwhile, the University has to arrange faculty on consolidated salary/lecture basis through proper advertisement given in leading newspapers, whenever faculty still remains in shortage due to one reason or the other. There are so many posts of teachers lying vacant under reservation categories because the Ph.D degree is essential qualification for the post of Assistant Professor. As per recent Office Order of Punjabi University, Patiala vide no. 6978 dated 14.02.2019 in the case of Sh. Gaganpreet Singh Sandhu working in Yadwindra College of Engg., Talwandi Sabo on contract basis as Assistant Professor, his salary has been increased from Rs. 21,600/- to Rs. 30,000/- per month alongwith grant of the annual increment w.e.f. 01.07.2018 and vide office order no. 33782-881 dated 21.08.2019, the salary has been increased from Rs. 30,000/- to Rs. 44,000/- per month w.e.f. October, 2019 (Annexure-31 from Page No. 238 to 239). Therefore, it is proposed that the rates for faculty on consolidated salary/lecture basis may be revised in the light of the abovementioned office order of Punjabi University, Patiala, i.e. from Rs. 21,600/- (Rupees Twenty One Thousand Six Hundred Only) to Rs. 35,000/- (Rupees Thirty Five Thousand Only) per month to candidates having Ph.D. degree and otherwise Rs. 30,000/- (Rupees Thirty Thousand Only) per month. The remaining 5.08 acres of land will be used for running of PIT, Rajpura after due approval from Board.
