



PROTOCOL OF COOPERATION

Between

Engineering Institute of Technology (EIT)

and

Maharaja Ranjit Singh Punjab Technical University (MRSPTU)

Dabwali Road, Bathinda, Punjab 151001, India Represented by Registrar, Prof. Jasbir Singh Hundal

Engineering Institute of Technology, hereinafter referred to as EIT, and Maharaja Ranjit Singh Punjab Technical University, hereinafter referred to as MRSPTU, confirm their interest in the development of co-operation in the field of student & faculty exchange, research and teaching to their mutual advantage, have agreed as follows.

Art. 1

This Agreement sets out the purpose, terms and conditions of cooperation between EIT and MRSPTU

Art. 2

This Agreement pertains to student & faculty exchange, teaching and research.

Art. 3

Both institutes agree on the following forms of cooperation:

in the field of education:

- to exchange experience in teaching methods,
- to exchange staff members for the purpose of giving lectures, taking part in seminars research academic etc.

in the field of research:

- to carry out joint research projects,
- to exchange scientific and technical information,
- to coordinate research studies.
- to exchange scientific results in specific fields of science,
- to publish the results in these fields,
- to organise joint seminars, conferences, symposia.
- to exchange resources.
- To collaborate between different research groups/labs etc.

in the field of student exchange:

- to create conditions enabling students to take undergraduate and postgraduate studies at a partner institution being a party to this agreement,
- to exchange students for a period of one semester or its part, or for a time needed to carry out a specific project, practical training or preparation of a thesis,
- to carry out joint research programmes by students,
- to exchange students under student traineeship schemes.





Art. 4

- In order to achieve specific objectives and tasks under this Agreement, Parties shall sign a separate detailed document which shall provide for the rules of cooperation in particular such as method of financing, time and period of the parties 'representatives' visits, financial liabilities academics monitoring, Intellectual Property Rights, other outcomes etc.
- Such agreements for specifies objectives may be signed at the respective institutions and exchanged.
- 3. Both MRSPTU and EIT will appoint respective 'Point of Contact(s)' for execution of this POC.

Art. 5

- The Parties agree to take necessary steps and ensure mutual support for the purpose of raising funds for the execution of this Agreement.
- This Agreement does not entail any financial consequences for any party.

Art. 6

- This Agreement enters into force on the day of its signature and is concluded for 5
 years.
- 2. If the parties, at least 6 months before expiration of this period, do not initiate to extend it, this Agreement terminates.
- 3. The Agreement may be terminated upon a prior written notice of termination submitted by the 30th of June of the given year with effect at the end of that calendar year.
- 4. All amendments to this Agreement are null and void unless made in writing.

Art. 7

1. This Agreement is made in English in four counterparts.
