DECISION: It was informed that Ph.D Fee Structure has been decided and notified. The Fee structure is as under,

6. Ph.D Thesis Submission cum Evaluation Fee: 25,000/- (one time)
7. Hostel Fee: As per Institute norms to be paid along with Semester fee (optional)

Late Fee/Extention/Resubmission Fees:

1. Extension of Ph.D course work beyond 1yr: Rs 5,000/- per course
2. Extension for thesis submission beyond 5 yrs from date of registration: Rs. 10,000/- (up to 6yrs)

**ITEM NO. 01.07 TO APPROVE THE PROPOSED ANTI-PLAGIARISM POLICY
FOR ETHICAL CONDUCT IN RESEARCH**

DECISION: It was informed that Anti-Plagiarism Policy has been framed for ethical conduct in research.

It was approved by the Council with comments that maximum 15% similarity is allowed in each chapter. Supervisors can avail the facility to check plagiarism in the University Library.

**ITEM NO. 01.08 TO APPROVE PG INSTITUTE REQUIREMENT FOR Ph.D
SUPERVISORS**

DECISION: It was proposed to discuss that what should the requirements for an Institute to be approved as PG Institute for the purpose that a regular faculty member teaching in it is eligible to act as Ph.D supervisor.

It was discussed and approved by the Council with the following recommendations,

At least any one of the following conditions should be met for a regular faculty member to become eligible as Ph.D Research Supervisor,

(i) The regular faculty member having Ph.D Degree should have experience of engaging Post Graduate Classes in his/her Institute.

Or

(ii) The faculty member should have at least 5 years of regular teaching/research experience and should have at least five research publications in SCI indexed journals.

**ITEM NO. 01.09 TO APPROVE ALL DEPARTMENTS OF THE CONSTITUENT
COLLEGE GZSCCET BATHINDA TO ACT AS Ph.D RESEARCH
CENTRES**

DECISION: It was informed that research facilities/resource requirements are either not available or are not up to the mark in many of the Affiliated Colleges, so it was proposed to approve that all departments of the Constituent College GZSCCET Bathinda were proposed to act as Ph.D Research Centres.

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ITEM NO. 01.10 TO DELIBERATE UPON UPPER AGE LIMIT FOR A FACULTY MEMBER TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR APPOINTMENT AS Ph.D SUPERVISOR/ PRINCIPAL INVESTIGATOR

DECISION: It was proposed to deliberate upon age limit for a faculty member to be eligible for appointment as Ph.D supervisor/principal investigator.

It was decided by the Council that,

1. A regular faculty member can act as Ph.D Research Supervisor up to age of 65 years.
2. A faculty member (non-regular) can act as Co-Supervisor after superannuation up to age of 65 years.
3. Beyond age of 65 years, even for regular faculty member (Emeritus Fellow), it is mandatory that there is also attached a Co-Supervisor.

ITEM NO. 01.11 TO APPROVE MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS NEEDED FOR A DEPARTMENT TO ACT AS APPROVED UNIVERSITY RESEARCH CENTRE

DECISION: It was informed that to impart quality research environment and facilities, desirable resource requirements have been proposed for allocating MRSSTU approved University Research Centre (URC) Status to a particular School/Department in an Affiliated Institute. It was proposed to approve it.

It was approved by the Council.

ITEM NO. 01.12 TO APPROVE Ph.D COURSE WORK EVALUATION PATTERN AND CURRICULUM TO BE FOLLOWED BASED ON PERCENTAGE SYSTEM RATHER THAN ON CREDIT SYSTEM, UNTIL NEW CURRICULUM BASED ON CREDIT SYSTEM IS IMPLEMENTED

DECISION: It was proposed to approve Ph.D Course Work Evaluation Pattern and Curriculum to be followed based on percentage system rather than on credit system, until new Curriculum based on credit system is implemented.

**ITEM NO. 01.15 TO APPROVE MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA & PET
SYLLABUS FOR ADMISSION TO Ph.D PROGRAMME IN A
DISCIPLINE AS RECOMMENDED BY CHAIRPERSONS OF
CONCERNED BOS**

DECISION: It was informed that Minimum Eligibility Criteria & PET Syllabus for admission to Ph.D Programme in a discipline have been proposed for approval.

DEPARTMENT GZSCCET, BATHINDA**

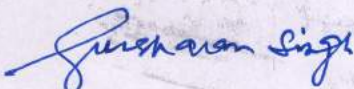

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ITEM NO. 01.18 TO APPROVE THE PROPOSED CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM

DECISION: It was proposed to start continued evaluation of the students from 2016-17 Academic Session based on Choice Based Credit System, as per guidelines of the UGC. This system will facilitate transfer of credits earned by a student across different Departments/Centres of other recognized/accredited Universities or Institutions of higher education in India and Abroad. It was proposed to approve it.

ITEM NO. 01.19 TO APPROVE THE PROPOSED MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR 2016-17 BATCH ADMISSIONS

DECISION: It was informed that minimum eligibility criteria for 2016-17 batch admissions for both AICTE and Non-AICTE Programmes have been prepared. It was proposed to approve it.

ITEM NO. 01.20 TO APPROVE THE PROPOSED NOMENCLATURE SYSTEM OF STUDENT UNIVERSITY REGISTRATION NUMBER

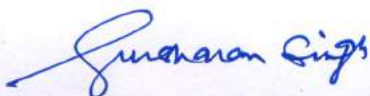
DECISION: A student registration number system was proposed to issue the student unique registration number which will be the same for the whole period of study in the Programme in which the student takes admission. It was proposed to approve it.

It was approved by the Council after incorporating suggestions made by the Council. Approved Student Registration Number System is given below,

STUDENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

All the students to be admitted in Affiliated/Constituent Colleges/Main Campus of MRSSTU will be identified by a unique ID consisting of 9 numeric characters (numbers), known as MRSSTU Student Registration Number.

1. TWO CHARACTER CODE FOR YEAR OF ADMISSION: 1st & 2nd numbers from left to right will signify the Year of Admission.



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2. **THREE CHARACTER PROGRAMME CODE:** 3rd, 4th & 5th numbers from left to right will represent the Programme, in which the student has been admitted. It will start from 001.
3. **FOUR CHARACTER UNIQUE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER:** 6th, 7th, 8th & 9th numbers from left to right will provide unique identification number to the student, specific to the Programme. It will start from 0001.
4. **ILLUSTRATION FOR REGISTRATION NUMBER:** Suppose a student has been admitted in 2016-17 July Batch Counselling, in B.Tech. Programme in Civil Engineering 1st Semester. MRSSTU has allotted 0043 unique identification number to the student, specific to B.Tech. Programme in Civil Engineering. B.Tech. Programme in Civil Engineering has numeric Programme Code 011. The MRSSTU Registration number of the student will be

Again, if a student has been admitted in 2016-17 July Batch Counselling, in M.Tech. Programme in Mechanical Engineering 1st Semester. MRSSTU has allotted 0012 unique identification number to the student, specific to M.Tech. Programme in Mechanical Engineering. M.Tech. Programme in Mechanical Engineering has numeric Programme Code 063. The MRSSTU Registration number of the student will be

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COURSE CODES

If a department offers only one Post Graduate, Under Graduate, Post Graduate Diploma, Diploma or Certificate Programme, then four alphabet Programme code will be followed by character 1.

For Example, if Department of Textile Engineering offers only one Under Graduate Programme - B.Tech. Textile Engineering, then its Programme code will be BTEX1. Similarly, if Department of Textile Engineering offers only one Post Graduate Programme - M.Tech. Textile Technology, then its Programme code will be MTEX1.

On the other hand, if Department of Mechanical Engineering offers two M.Tech. Programmes, then four alphabets of these Programme codes will be the same, but these will be followed by different characters. So, we will have: M.Tech. CAD/CAM Programme having code MMEE1 & M.Tech. Mechanical Engineering Programme having code MMEE2.

If a Course being offered by a Department is not specific to its own Programme then four alphabets of this Programme will be followed by 0. For example, Applied Mathematics-I Course being offered to B.Tech. Programme is not specific to Programme of Mathematics Department. So Applied Mathematics-I Course Code is BMAT0-101. Similarly, if a Course being offered by a Department of its Programme is common with Programmes of other Departments, again this character will be zero. For example, Basics of Electrical Engineering Course offered by Electrical Engineering Department is common with other B.Tech. Programmes, like Civil, Electronics, Mechanical, etc. So Basics of Electrical Engineering Course Code is BELE0-101.

1. EIGHT CHARACTER CODE FOR COURSES OF A PROGRAMME:

Each Course code will consist of eight character including five characters of the Programme code (from left to right). 6th character of the Course code will be a number to represent semester. 10th, 11th and 12th semesters will be represented by X, Y & Z characters, wherever applicable.

7th and 8th characters will be numbers as given below:

Departmental Core/Fundamental Courses: 01 to 55

Departmental Electives: 56 to 90

Open Electives offered by the Department: 91 to 99.

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2. ILLUSTRATION FOR COURSE CODE OF A PROGRAMME:

If Department of Civil Engineering offers, A Departmental Core/Fundamental Course at B.Tech. level in 3rd Semester, then its code may be BCIE1309.

A Departmental Elective Course at B.Tech. level in 5th Semester, then its code may be BCIE1562.

An Open Elective Course at B.Tech. level in 6th Semester, then its code may be BCIE1693.

A Departmental Core Course at M.Tech. level in 2nd Semester, then its code may be MCIE-3209. Here 3 signifies that Department of Civil Engineering offers more than one M.Tech. Programmes.

3. Some Courses will be handled by Department of Humanities (HUM).

ITEM NO. 01.21 TO APPROVE THE PROPOSED CODES OF PROGRAMMES & COURSES

DECISION: It was informed that Codes have been prepared for the Programmes and Courses of Study to be offered from 2016-17 Academic Session. It was proposed to approve them.

It was approved by the Council after incorporating the following suggestions given by the Council,

Each Programme will have two types of Codes (**Appendix-II**),

1. Programme Numeric Code only for University Registration Number.
2. Programme Alphanumeric Code only for Course Codes.

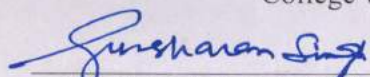
For example, B.Tech. Programme in Civil Engineering has Numeric Code 011 for University Registration Number and Alphanumeric Code BCIE1 for Course Codes.

ITEM NO. 01.22 TO DISCUSS AND APPROVE THE PROPOSED MRSSTU MIGRATION RULES-2016

DECISION: It was informed that new Migration Rules have been prepared to be implemented for 2016 batch onwards students. It was proposed to approve it.

Migration will be allowed after 2nd Semester in 3rd Semester. Every College will upload on its website the vacant seats available for migration



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and the schedule for submission of application form for migration, at least seven days before the closing date. Migration in higher Semester will be allowed only in special cases with the permission of Vice Chancellor, to be approved by BOG.

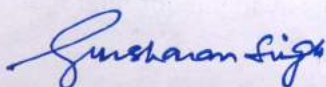

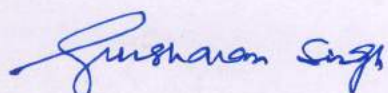

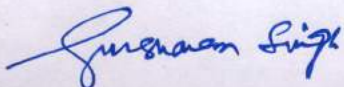
