Subject: Revised Eligibility Rules for participation of students/athletes in National University Games: 2017-18 onwards.

- 1. The matter with regard to revised Eligibility Rules was considered and discussed thread-bare in the meeting. Sports Board decided to adopt and approve the decision of International University Sports Federation (FISU) regarding the amendment/change in "Age Limit" for participation of student athletes in FISU sporting competitions from 2017-18 onwards. Accordingly, the new approved "Age Limit" from 17 to 25 years shall be applicable for participation of Indian Universities contingent/teams in all the sporting events, including the discipline of Basketball organized by the FISU.
- Lot of queries have been pouring in AIU office from the member universities regarding Revised Eligibility Rules as these are mandatory for the purpose of admission and selection of teams for participation at zonal and Inter Zonal(National) tournaments.
- 3. Further, it was also decided to implement the above Age limit from 17 to 25 years alongwith existing "eligibility conditions" put in place for participation of bonafide and full time (regular) students, for participation in National University Games from 2017-18 onwards alongwith following additional terms and conditions:
- 4. Accordingly, a copy of Revised Eligibility Rules is uploaded on our website <u>www.aiu.ac.in</u> for advance information and necessary action of all the stakeholders. Further, a copy of the same is being circulated to all member universities for advance information of all the stakeholders in due course of time.
 - Age limit of the students shall be minimum 17 years and maximum upto 25 years
 - Only a bonafide, full time student, who is enrolled for a course of the University, which
 is of a minimum duration of one academic year, and whose examination is conducted
 by the university, shall be eligible to participate in the Inter-University tournaments.
 - Students of open Universities shall be considered to be bonafied students and shall be eligible to participate provided they fulfil other conditions.
 - Ph.D., M. Phil., Compartment, etc. students will be eligible to participate only if in terms
 of the concerned university rules they are regarded to be bonafide students and fulfil
 other conditions laid down in this behalf.All students participating in the Inter University
 Tournaments shall fulfil the following conditions:
 - Not more than 8 years have elapsed since a student passed the examination qualifying him/her for first admission to a university or college affiliated to a university. The 8 year period mentioned above shall be distributed as below:-
 - not more than 5 years after passing 10+2 or equivalent while pursuing graduate courses/studies.

- ii. Not more than 3 years after passing Graduation or equivalent while pursuing post graduate course/studies. irrespective of any other conditions like change of class/course/faculty, joining lower class from higher, changing academic to professional courses or vice versa, provided that students admitted, after passing +2 examination, to graduate courses of more than 3 years duration like Medical, Engineering, Agriculture, Pharmacy etc. shall be eligible to participate in the Inter-University tournaments for the actual length of such graduate courses/studies.
- Only students, who are less than 25 years of age as on first July of the academic year in which the tournament is held, can participate.
- Students shall not be full-time employees of Public or Private sector as the case may be
- A student shall not be allowed to represent more than one University during a single academic year.
- Provisional admission to a course or University shall not make the student eligible to represent the University.
- In case of a student migrating from one University to another, his/her migration case will
 be considered eligible only after his/her admission in the new university is regularized
 and he/she is admitted as a bonafide student by the new university.
- No Objection Certificate (NOC) is mandatory to be eligible for participation for those students, who received or receiving stipend/financial support for pursuing excellence in competitive sports as career from Public or Private Sector to support their studies, as the case may be.

Note: As per existing practice, the comments and queries with regard to the Revised Eligibility Rules received from member universities, if any, will be reported to the next Sports Board Meeting for consideration.

- b) The photograph is also to be attested by the principal.
- c) If any member of an inter-college team is proven to be imposing for some other student of his admission in that college is proven to be fake, the whole team may be debarred from further participation in that tournament.
- d) Further the team of that college may be debarred from taking part in that sport for the next three years.
- e) The DPE/sports officer may be held responsible for sending that team and strictures may be sent against him/her to their college for action to be taken by the college management.
- 1.1.8 a) During the inter-college tournament if any dispute arises, it is proposed that the panel of jury comprising of following may decide the matter.
 - I. Principal/Director of Host College (Chairman)
 - II. Observer of tournament (Vice-chairman)
 - III. Representative of MRSSTU (Member)
 - IV. Senior most conduct official (Member)
 - V. DPE of Host College (Member secretary)

The tournament may continue despite the result of the objection or any other matter and under no circumstances the tournament may be stopped. The organizing secretary would not have any right to stop any player or any team from participation in the tournament.

- b) If the objection is against or by the Host College then committee members at serial number I & V may not be part of the committee. This committee may take on the spot decision without interrupting the tournament. If dispute is not resolved then the matter may be referred to the exigency committee comprising the three members from outside MRSSTU circle. In this case the observer may give his report and the committee gives decision after reaching the venue or on telephone which may be conveyed to all the disputing parties by the observer. It is proposed that the final appellate authority in any case be the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor.
- **1.1.9** It is proposed that every affiliated college may send only one sports team to Inter-college sports tournaments.
- 1.1.10 Participation in Inter-college sports tournaments; inter-varsity sports tournaments, National or Inter-National sports tournaments with prior permission of the university may be considered as on duty. If during the above mentioned events the students miss sessional exams, the college may hold these exams as per the convenience of everyone

- involved. Every college may organize extra lectures for all the lectures lost by a student during the duty period described above.
- 1.1.11 It is proposed that the first three position winners for overall (Men & Women combined) championship be given monetary incentive to develop sports infrastructure in their college. The monetary incentive may be:
 - a) Winner of overall championship-Rs.2, 00,000/-.
 - b) Runners-up of overall championship-Rs.1, 00, 000/-.
 - c) Third position in overall championship-Rs. 50,000/-.
 - d) DPE/Sports Officer of the winning colleges may be given blazer cloth at the awards function. For this purpose, colleges may be asked for proposal to buy sports infrastructure. After the proposal is cleared, a committee may be formed consisting of the principal of the college, DPE or any other faculty member nominated by the principal and Director Finance of the university or his nominee thereof.
- **1.1.12** The colleges which do not submit their accounts to the university till April of each year may not be given hosting rights of any Inter-college tournament in the next session.
- 1.1.13 The colleges may be asked to send their sports letters or sports entries on e-mail addresses.
- **1.1.14** Host College may submit declaration certificate regarding completion of the tournament along with fund utilization Performa.
- **1.1.15** It is proposed that host College will arrange all equipments pertaining to the tournament to be organized by it.
- 1.1.16 It is proposed that MRSSTU tournament and other sports events be held as per AIU rules and sports federation of India rules. However in unavoidable circumstances these rules may be amended to suit the local conditions.

Matter is placed before the committee for consideration and approval please.

1.2 Rules and Regulation of Inter Varsity Tournaments

1.2.1 It is proposed that in eligibility performs an undertaking from each member of the team be taken that if they are selected to represent M.R.S.S.T.U. in inter-varsity tournament they will participate in it. If student/ students of a college do not report for the intervarsity camp, their college may be sent a letter asking explanation regarding absence of their students form intervarsity camp.
