Decision:

After deliberation it was decided to appoint Two (2) officials/umpires instead of one for the game of hockey. Whereas for the game of chess it was decided to appoint one official against the proposed 2 officials and the remuneration will remain same as approved earlier.

It was also decided to fix the officiating rates to conduct official/umpire/table official Rs. 400/- per head per match subject to maximum Rs. 1000/- per day per head for hockey tournament.

Item No. 4.4. Proposal for remuneration to conduct officials of newly introduced Inter-College tournaments.

In the absence of any specific guidelines of AIU regarding number of officials and payment of amount to them. The conduct officials may be appointed as per the rules of concerned National Federation. The remuneration should be paid by the host University in accordance with its existing rules. The number and remuneration for conduct officials proposed and approved through agenda item no. 3.4 is as below:

Guidelines of various Universities in this regard placed at Annexure- VI-VII may be considered. Officiating charges Rs. 800/- per head per day has already been approved by Sports Executive Committee of MRSPTU for Swimming, Cross

Country, Power Lifting, and Weight lifting, Best Physique, Cycling and Athletics.

Decision:

It was decided to appoint one official instead of two as proposed for the game shooting. Remuneration for the same shall be paid @ Rs. 800/- per day per head.

It was also decided to appoint minimum six (6) officials for Taekwondo tournament and number of officials may increase according to participation of players. As per respective federation rules the committee authorized the chairman to take decision on the matter later for the Taekwondo tournament.

Item No. 4.5. Amendment in the TA & DA to conduct officials/tournament Observers for various Inter-College tournaments.

For payment of TA & DA to conduct officials and tournament observers as per their grade pay. It is proposed that TA & DA for Inter-College tournaments observer and conduct officials will be amended as below:

Decision:

It was decided that Central/Punjab govt. officials having specific grade pay will be paid TA as per their entitlement, whereas officials from private sector/affiliated institutions shall be paid actual ordinary bus fare subject to production of tickets or maximum Rs. 150/- per day.

Item No. 4.6. Clarification in Grant to Host College/Institute for organizing Inter-College Football tournament.

Grant for Hosting Inter-College Football tournament is approved for Zonal and Inter-Zonal venues separately Rs. 35,000/- for each zone and Rs. 15,000/- for final. Football matches has been organized at single venue only including the finals during previous sessions due to less number of participating teams. To meet the expenses of single venue tournament, Grant to Host College/Institute for organizing Inter-College Football tournament will be amended as below:

Decision:

It was decided that Football tournament will be held only at single venue instead of zone basis and grant for the same is enhanced to Rs. 40,000/- from existing Rs. 35,000/-

Item No. 4.7. Cash Incentive to the sports achievers.

It is proposed to continue the same cash incentives to the sports achievers for session 2018-19 as approved by finance committee of the University in Item no. 2.8 for session 2017-18 placed at **Annexure – VIII.**

Decision:

Approved with the suggestion that cash incentives will be given to the eligible sports achievers on the occasion of annual Inter-College Athletic tournament of the University.

Item No. 4.8. Organization of Summer Coaching Camps for selected players.

It is proposed that a summer coaching camp shall be organized during summer vacations at the university main campus for improvement of sports performance of players of its main campus, constituent and affiliated colleges/institutes. TA, Meal expenses/diet money and refreshment will be paid to the participants as per approved rates in first meeting of agenda item no.7 and second meeting of agenda item no. 2.4.1, 2.4.2 and 2.4.3 for Inter-University participants, team managers and coaches. (Annexure- IX-X)

It is also proposed that if summer coaching camp is to be organized during summer vacations at any hill station for high altitude training of players of its main campus, constituent and affiliated colleges/institutes. TA, Accommodation charges, Meal expenses/diet money and refreshment will be paid to the participants, managers and coaches as per approved rates of Government Regional Mountaineering Centre situated in the region. (Annexure –XI)

Decision:

It was decided to organize summer coaching camp during vacations for maximum 50 players at the University campus or in the institutions of university jurisdiction. Diet money including refreshment @150/- per participant shall be paid.

Item No. 4.9. Amendment in Term Daily Allowance (DA) to players for Inter-College tournaments & students attending coaching Camp and participation in the Inter-Varsity tournaments including journey days.

The daily allowance (DA) approved through Item No. 1.1.5 and 2.4.1 will remain as it is. The term daily allowance will be replaced as diet money to overcome technical/financial hindrances regarding payment to the players of Host Institute. (Annexure – XII, X)

Decision: Approved.

Decision:

It was decided to reduce the minimum requirement of teams to four (04) to organize Inter-College tournaments for both men/women.

Item No. 4.11. Rules for drawing fixtures of Inter-College Tournaments.

It is proposed that if there are 4 or less than 4 entries received for an Inter-College tournament then fixture will be drawn on league basis otherwise fixture will be drawn on knock-out basis and governed by the instruction approved through agenda item no. 5 of first sports executive committee meeting. Whereas Inter-College Cricket tournament will be governed by the following rules:

- 1. It will be a knock-out cum knock-out tournament.
- 2. Matches will be played on West & East Zone venues.
- 3. West Zone comprises six districts i.e. Ferozepur, Fazilika, Faridkot, Muktsar, Bathinda & Mansa.
- 4. East Zone comprises five districts i.e. Patiala, Fatehgarh Sahib, Sangrur, Moga & Barnala.
- 5. First semi-final match will be played between winner of west Zone and Runner-up of East Zone. Second semi-final will be played between winner of East Zone and Runner-up of west zone.
- 6. Zone matches will be of 30 over and semi-final, third place & final match will be of 40 over.
- 7. The matches will be governed by the STANDARD ONE-DAY INTERNATIONAL MATCH PLAYING CONDITIONS of ICC.
- 8. In the event of a tied match the teams will compete in a SUPER OVER to determine the winner.

The Committee also authorized the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor-cum- Chairman of the committee to permit the conduct of the game/sports not in the list. He is also authorized to provide the grant for the same.

Item No. 4.13. Participation in Inter-University competitions for session 2018-19.

It is proposed to field those teams in the Inter University tournaments, for which University organizes Inter-College competitions. In no circumstances a game not recommended by the Sports Executive Committee shall be fielded in the inter University tournament.

In case of outstanding sports persons belong to the games in which University does not organize Inter-College competitions. Selection trails shall be conducted only with the permission of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, if case forwarded by the Principal/Director of concerned College to Director Sports well in advance with Authenticated proofs of students' performance.

However, if the selection committee feels that performance of players is far below the Inter-University standards then the committee may reject the selection of University team.

Decision:

Approved

Item No. 4.14. Participation of constituent and affiliated colleges in Inter-College tournaments.

It is proposed that it should be mandatory for all the constituent and affiliated colleges to take part in minimum three (3) Inter-College tournament from the session 2018-19. It will be helpful to increase the participation of colleges in the Inter-College tournaments.

Decision:

Issue was discussed in detail. Suggestions were sought from the experts present in the meeting to increase the participation of colleges.

- i. Dr. Parminder Singh was of view that cash incentives should be given to the sports achievers.
- ii. Prof. (Dr.) Mohan Pal Singh Ishar Chairman of the committee endorsed that partial assistance will be given to those institution who won tournament of a particular game for continuously three (3) years.

Apart from these above items of agenda, some issue were raised by the members present in the meeting with the permission of chair. Following issues were presented as the Table Agenda items.

Item No. 1 Regarding retaining of winner trophy.

Sh. Manjinder Singh (DPE), Alpine Institute, Rode has raised the issue regarding retaining of winner trophies. In the same context, It was decided that winner of particular game for continuously three (3) years shall retain the trophy. It was also suggested by other experts that efforts should be made for the sponsorship of trophies from the renowned personalities of the region.

11 Conduct of play: umpires

- 11.1 Two umpires control the match, apply the Rules and are the judges of fair play.
- 11.2 Each umpire has primary responsibility for decisions in one half of the field for the duration of the match.
- 11.3 Each umpire is responsible for decisions on free hits in the circle, penalty corners, penalty strokes and goals in one half of the field.
- 11.4 Umpires are responsible for keeping a written record of goals scored and of warning or suspension cards used.
- 11.5 Umpires are responsible for ensuring that the full time is played and for indicating the end of time for each half and for the completion of a penalty corner if a half is prolonged.
- 11.6 Umpires blow the whistle to:
 - a start and end each half of the match
 - b start a bully
 - c enforce a penalty
 - d start and end a penalty stroke
 - e indicate a goal
 - f re-start the match after a goal has been scored
 - g re-start the match after a penalty stroke when a goal was not scored
 - h stop the match for the substitution onto or off the field of a fully equipped goalkeeper and to restart the match on completion of the substitution
 - i stop the match for any other reason and to re-start it
 - j indicate, when necessary, that the ball has passed wholly outside the field.

7. Instructions for the team managers accompanying university teams for participation in all India inter-varsity tournaments

- 7.1 The team Manager/contingent In-charge may collect all the relevant papers of team/ contingent such as identity cards and the money from host University, eligibility Performa, identity cards and the money from the office of the Director, Sports well in time.
- 7.2 The reservation for the journey be got done well in time, to avoid any last minute rush/non/availability. Original fare/reservation charges receipt are required to be attached with the adjustment account.
- 7.3 The amount spent on bus fare is to be filled in the prescribed Performa obtaining signatures of all the team players. If possible, tickets of bus fare are to be attached with the adjustment account.
- 7.4 Daily allowance of Rs.175/- per day may be paid to students attending coaching camps and participating in the Inter-Varsity tournaments including journey days and for which individual receipt on the prescribed Performa is to be obtained from all the team members under revenue stamp, if required, The DA @ Rs 200/- may also be allowed to team Manager during camp and Rs.500/- during actual participation and travelling days. The Coach may be entitled for DA @ 500/- during camp, actual participation and travelling days.
- 7.5 The Managers may not purchase any kit or equipment for the team. These items may be collected from the office of the Director, Sports. In case some essential item is required in emergency, then before procurement prior written permission of the Director, Sports is to be obtained.
- 7.6 No cooliage charges be admissible to the teams except for cooliage charges of kit bag of cricket team.
- 7.7 Distribution list of kit duly signed by the recipient, payment of TA/ DA to the Coach and Manager be made only after checking/verifying the calculations by the Accounts section of the University on their return.
- 7.8 A certificate from the Organizing Secretary to the effect that transportation has not been provided by the host University has to be obtained and attached with the adjustment account. In case Scooter/Rickshaw charges are claimed, actual payee receipt is to be obtained indicating distance covered and attached with the adjustment account.
- 7.9 No medical claim be admissible except for the medicines prescribed by the **Medical**Officer to the member(s). However, Iodex, medicine and Glucose etc. can be purchased, if required by the team. Prescription chit also be attached.
- 7.10 The team is required to start return journey within 24 hours after losing a fixture. Relieving certificate is to be obtained from the host University and to be submitted along with adjustment account.

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Maharaja Ranjit Singh State Technical University, Bathinda has been established as an affiliating University vide Punjab Act No. 5 of 2015 notified through Punjab Government Gazette-Extraordinary (Regd. No.CHD/0092/2015-2017) notification No. 5-Leg. /2015 dated 12th February 2015.

The University is to hold the Sports Activity for its affiliated and constituent colleges/institutes in near future. Officiating fee/participation fee/TA & DA for students and officials, honorarium, grant to host institutions, other entitlements of students/officials and other expenses shall be same as being followed by IKG PTU, Jalandhar for the session 2015-16.

1. Rules and Regulations

1.1 Rules and Regulation for Inter College Tournaments

- 1.1.1 All inter-college tournaments proposed to be held under aegis of MRSSTU Bathinda.
- 1.1.2 Consent be sought from all affiliated colleges for hosting of tournaments.
- 1.1.3 Tournaments with budgetary provisions may be allocated to host colleges by the council.
- 1.1.4 Every college wishing to participate in any M.R.S.S.T.U. inter-college tournament be asked to send the eligibility Performa at least three days before the commencement of tournament to get a support in the fixture of the tournament. No exception be made in any case.
- 1.1.5 It is proposed that students be paid daily allowance at the rate of Rs 125/day for the journey period and for actual participating days during the conduct of inter-college tournament by their own college. Students may be paid refreshment at the rate of Rs 25/day for the pre tournament camp (minimum duration of 15 days) and actual participating days during the conduct of inter-college tournaments by their own college. The camp may include 50% more students than the actual strength of the team.
- 1.1.6 For every new sport started by the university and the existing sport, it is proposed that there may be at least five (5) teams in men section and four (4) teams in women section for the tournament to take place. A sport in which inter-college is not conducted; the sports department may put a notice on university web site asking for names of interested students from all MRSSTU affiliated colleges and then conduct trials at a suitable venue. The nomination lists may have to be attested by the principal of the college.
- 1.1.7 To discourage malpractices in inter-college tournament regarding the practice of outside players representing a college team, it is proposed that:
 - a) Each player will carries his fee slip of current semester, 10th/metric certificate, 10+2 certificate and photo identity card duly attested by the principal.
