The Maharaja Ranjit Singh Punjab Technical University (MRSPTU), Bathinda was established in 2015 by the Government of Punjab with the vision to contribute towards the state, the nation and the world through advancement for attaining excellence in technical education and research, and to provide quality human resource having high professional and ethical conduct to serve the needs of the industry and society. The University is approved under section 2(f) and 12 (B) of UGC. The University is offering doctoral, post graduate, graduate, diploma and certificate level courses in Engineering, Pharmacy, Sciences, Food Technology, Management, Architecture etc. through its campus, constituent colleges and affiliated colleges under its jurisdiction, spreading across 11 districts of Punjab.

The All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Bathinda is the premiere institute of national importance in the field of medical science and research. AIIMS Bathinda is 750 bedded central Government institute of national importance developed in 2019 under PMSSY, Ministry of Health and Family welfare, Government of India. Department of Hospital Administration in AIIMS Bathinda trains physician executives under expertised MD Hospital Administration faculty. Having an MBBS, MD Hospital Administration faculty at AIIMS Bathinda unfolds and wide range of opportunities for business students to understand the functioning of the hospital services that will in term develop leadership and problem-solving skills required in growing healthcare sectors nationally and internationally.

Both, Maharaja Ranjit Singh Punjab Technical University (MRSPTU) and All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) realized the need of establishing a close linkage between them to complement and further promote research and academic activities in this region of Punjab. In harmony of with this idea, Maharaja Ranjit Singh Punjab Technical University (MRSPTU) and All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) have expressed a desire to join hands for the cause

of promotion of collaborative courses in the field of Medical, Management and engineering, quality collaborative research and high end science. Therefore, Maharaja Ranjit Singh Punjab Technical University (MRSPTU) and All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) have decided to sign this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), to initiate joint need based academic and research programmes between the two organizations in broad area of Medical Sciences, Hospital Administration, Analytics, Engineering and Technology as per the following terms and conditions.

1. GENERAL

- Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) as an accredited centre for pursuing research and academic programmes at Master level and Doctorate level and relevant skill certification courses of the university in the designated subjects of Hospital administration, Management. Pharmacy, and Paramedical sciences and other areas of mutual interest. All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) will recognize Maharaja Ranjit Singh Punjab Technical University (MRSPTU) as an accredited centre for pursuing research and academic programmes at Masters level and Doctorate level and relevant skill certification courses of the university in the designated subjects of Hospital administration, Management, Pharmacy, and Paramedical sciences and other areas of mutual interest.
- 1.2 Faculty members of AIIMS and various departments of MRSPTU will jointly work towards developing research projects in areas of common interest, thereby mutually using the research facilities and other infrastructure of each other on mutually agreed terms and conditions.
- 1.3 Maharaja Ranjit Singh Punjab Technical University (MRSPTU) would recognize and accreditate faculty of All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Bathinda for guiding research leading to Masters, Ph.D. degrees as supervisor or co-supervisor as per UGC norms.
- 1.4 The faculty and students of the concerned centres of Maharaja Ranjit Singh Punjab Technical University shall facilitate access to each other's laboratory, library and other facilities as per rules.

2. ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES

- 2.1 Maharaja Ranjit Singh Punjab Technical University (MRSPTU) and All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) will work closely to generate appropriately trained manpower in the areas of Medical Sciences, Hospital Administration, Clinical Research, Project Management, Hospital Engineering and other relevant areas of mutual interest, which can further be revised from time to time, through organization of formal academic curricula, seminars, symposia, workshops, short term training courses and exchange of faculty and students.
- 2.2 Both the universities shall cooperate in education, innovation and research in areas of mutual interest and will support each other's endeavours in delivery of academic programmes and research activities through the following but not limited to:
 - Exchange of scientific and technical information
 - Joint supervision of postgraduate and Ph.D. students
 - Conducting collaborative research activities through participation in national and international research projects of various funding agencies.
 - Both the institutions shall identify faculty members, which may be given visiting or adjunct faculty appointments in accordance with the norms and procedures of host institutions.
 - Training of students and faculty for skill development related to courses
 - Any other objectives as agreed upon in writing by both the institutions.
- 2.3 The credit sharing for publications emerging out of collaborative research will be decided by the collaborating faculty of both the institutions.
- 2.4 Any other benefit or financial benefits will be shared on mutually decided terms on case to case basis.
- It is agreed that the progress of this MOU shall be monitored by a review committee comprising
 of the Vice Chancellor /Director of respective organizations, or their nominees through periodic
 meetings.
- 4. No party shall have the right to use the name or logo of another party without the prior approval of that party in writing.

- 5. This MOU is valid for a period of 05 years from the date of its signing subject to further extension on mutually agreed terms and conditions. Any mid term change/alteration in the terms and conditions of this MOU as suggested by the review committee shall also be deemed to be valid for both the organizations.
- 6. The terms of this MOU may be modified/amended at any time subject to mutual written agreement. Such notification shall be effective from the date on which both the parties execute them in writing.
- 7. The MOU may be terminated if any of the parties want to withdraw from it. In case of such premature termination, the MOU will terminate six months after the date of written notification or date of expiry of the MOU, whichever is earlier and all rights and obligations of both parties shall automatically cease except for the thesis projects of students and those covered under written contacts including ongoing collaborative activity that can no longer be cancelled.
- 8. Termination of MOU shall be done in cost effective manner subject to proper accounting of expenses that may have been incurred, where applicable. Either party may terminate this agreement by giving three (03) months' written notice to the other party.

<u>Mode of Admissions in Collaborative Courses</u> - Merit Basis/Entrance Test/ Interview (Mutually decided by two parties)

Application Processing and Fee Collection for Collaborative Courses

 Robust online platform will be provided by MRSPTU for application processing and fee collection.

Admission Process

- Advertisement will be given on the website of both, MRSPTU and AIIMS as well as through print media
- Interview panel will be comprised of faculties from AIIMS and MRSPTU Bathinda (if required)
- The entrance test will be prepared by AIIMS and MRSPTU and will be conducted in MRSPTU main campus (if required)

This MoU may pave way for many new courses in collaboration between two institutions.
