1.2	<p><b>REGARDING MINIMUM DURATION FOR SUBMISSION OF THESIS</b></p> <p>As per MRSP/PU Ph.D Regulations-2016 (Clause 10.1) the minimum period required for submission of thesis is three years from the date of enrolment. As it results in the delay in thesis completion of Ph.D degree/research work, therefore it is proposed that the minimum period for submission of thesis may be reduced to 30 months instead of 36 months. 
Thus, time period of 6 months post clearance the Pre-Ph.D course Work has lapsed for the under mentioned Ph.D research scholars.
