Thus, it is proposed that the Ph.D thesis submission and evaluation of be carried out by the Controller of Examination (CoE) of the University. 2.3	CONDUCT OF Ph.D ENTRANCE TEST ONCE IN A YEAR It has been proposed to conduct Ph.D Entrance Test (PET) once in a year. In the MRSPTU Ph.D Regulations - 2016, it was proposed to take Ph.D Entrance Test once a year. In 3 rd meeting of Academic Council held on 16 th Nov, 2018, It was approved to take Ph.D Entrance Test twice a year. The conduct of Ph.D Entrance Test twice a year is expensive because very less number of candidates are available for the Ph.D entrance test in December. Moreover, all other State Universities, like, IKGPTU, Jalandhar; Punjabi University, Patiala and GNDU, Amritsar conducts Ph.D Entrance Test only once a year. Thus, It is proposed to conduct Ph.D Entrance Test once a year as per MRSPTU Ph.D Regulations - 2016. (Annexure - II) Item is put before the URB for approval.
