- 3. The quorum for the meeting including the Chairperson, but excluding the special invitee, shall be
- 4. In considering the grievances before it, the SGRC shall follow principles of natural justice.
- 5. The SGRC shall send its report with recommendations, if any, to the competent authority of the institution concerned and a copy there of to the aggrieved student, preferably within a period of 15 working days from the date of receipt of the complaint, as per the procedure set specified under above regulations of UGC.
- 6. Any student aggrieved by the decision of the Students Grievance Redressal Committee may prefer an appeal to the ombudsperson, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of such decision. This order issued with the approval of the Higher Authority of the University.
