**ITEM NO. 24.1 REGARDING APPROVAL OF THE LEGAL ADVICE IN COCP 1578 of 2025 TITLED DR GURPRIT SINGH BATH V/S MS SHRUTI SINGH IAS AND OTHERS W.R.T. IMPLEMENTATION OF PENSION IN THE CASE PERTAINING TO CONVERSION OF CPF TO GPF.**

The matter regarding the approval of the legal advice w.r.t. conversion of CPF to GPF was put in the 23rd meeting of Board of Governors of the University held on 05-01-2026 vide agenda item no. 23.1.

The crux of the legal opinion of the Advocate already sought and put up in the previous meeting of the Board is as under:

***“University should immediately recall and scrap the Circular No. UNI/Estb/3061 dated 26-10-2022 and return the amount got deposited to the persons who are seeking conversion from CPF to GPF along with interest thereon as applicable to GPF/CPF from the date of deposit till the date of disbursement”.***

The matter was discussed in detail and decided to seek the following information:

- i. Financial implications/liability w.r.t. implementation of the decision pertaining to conversion from CPF to GPF.***
- ii. The opinion of the Department of Finance, Govt. of Punjab be taken w.r.t. the matter above.***

*In case of need, the opinion of the Advocate General of Punjab can also be taken for the same. The matter be put up again for decision by the Board of Governors before the due date of next hearing i.e. 24.02.2026.*

In compliance to the same, a committee was constituted vide office order no. Uni./Estb./014/091 dated 13-01-2026 to review of calculations and financial obligations for implementation of conversion from CPF Scheme to GPF Scheme for the employees of GZSCCET MRSPTU Bathinda.

The committee has submitted calculation sheet for the pension liability of the University for granting the pension to the above employees for a period of fifteen years from the date of their retirement.

The calculations were performed on the basis of the pay as per the 6th PPC and 7th CPC for non-teaching and teaching employees respectively. The above calculations are also vetted from the Chartered Accountant (**Annexure-1**).

Below is the summary of the calculations submitted by the committee thereafter vetted by the Chartered Accountant.

<b><i>Inflow amount (Contribution):</i></b>	<b><i>₹ 6,00,50,032/-</i></b>
<b><i>Outflow amount (Pension):</i></b>	<b><i>₹ 1,10,62,83,487/-</i></b>
<b><i>Financial Liability (including Interest @ 7.1% P.A.):</i></b>	<b><i>₹ -2,42,77,31,260/-</i></b>

As per the directions of the Vice Chancellor, MRSPTU Bathinda, the above calculations were put up before the committee constituted vide office order no. 1804 dated 04-11-2025 to look into the legal opinion in CPF to GPF conversion case of employees.

The meeting of the above committee was convened vide office order no. Uni./Reg./119 dated 20-01-2026. The following are the recommendations of the committee **(Annexure-2):**

*All the committee members agreed that the financial liability of the University in this regard is huge. The committee members are of the opinion that the liability along with the legal opinion may be put to the BoG for further necessary action as desired.*

In view of the next hearing in the COCP No. 1578 of 2025 fixed on 24.02.2026, the legal opinion in this regard and huge financial liability to the University, the matter is placed for kind consideration and decision please.
